

STATEMENT ON PUBLICATION ETHICS AND MALPRACTICE PREVENTION

The journal e-Zbornik follows the highest ethical and professional standards and has a zero tolerance to malpractice and plagiarism.

The Editorial Board, as well as the reviewers appointed by the Editorial Board, have the task of preventing unethical practices: falsifying research results, fabricating them and representing them as real, manipulating research procedures, intentionally changing or omitting data, using other people's results, opinions or judgments as one's own without acknowledging the source, misusing research subjects or materials, attempting to cover up possible violations of ethical guidelines, misrepresentation of interest, violation of confidentiality.

This task is based on the COPE (<u>Committee of Publication Ethics</u>) <u>Code of Conduct and Best Practice</u> <u>Guidelines for Journal Editors</u> according to which areas of responsibility of the Editor-in-Chief as well as the Editorial Board, Council, reviewers and authors of the papers are defined.
